One

Splash (Title Page): Dragon seen soaring through the sky. The title is above the dragon, in the middle of its wingspan.

Two

Panel 1: Close up on The Person's eyes.

Narration: "I see it every few months." Between **panel 1** and **panel 2**.

Panel 2: Close up on a dragon's eyes.

Panel 3 (bleed): Full body of the dragon in a regal pose, similar to a deer.

Narration: "It's plagued my dreams for years."

Three

Panel 1: The Person's hand is outstretched.

Narration: "But every time I try to approach it..." Between **panel 1** and **panel 2**.

Panel 2: The dragon's head is turning. Zip lines are used to show movement.

Panel 3: The dragon is backing away. The edges of the panel are blurred in black.

Narration: "It leaves."

Panel 4: Close up on The Person's closed eyes (sleeping).

Panel 5: Completely black.

SFX: five BEEP's increasing in size.

Panel 6: close up on The Person's eyes wide open (awake).

Four

Panel 1: The Person is sitting up in bed, arm stretched unusually long to turn off a classic alarm clock.

There is an egg situated on top of a dresser next to the person's bed.

Panel 2: Close up on the egg, with the person in the background behind it. The Person is giving the egg a dirty look out of the corner of their eye.

Narration: "Fuckass thing hasn't done anything for the last decade."

Panel 3: Egg with parallel vertical squiggled lines to show embarrassment/awkwardness.

Narration: "I've researched and applied almost every possible method to get this thing to hatch."

Panel 4 (flashback montage): The egg is being lit on fire by The Person with flaming match sticks in their hands.

Narration: "Arson."

Panel 5 (flashback montage): The egg is in the middle of a witch's ritual, with dead plants and animals surrounding it.

Narration: "Ritual Sacrifice."

Panel 6 (flashback montage): The egg is cuddled with The Person in bed and under a blanket. They are watching a movie on the computer.

Narration: "Peace and love."

Dialogue: "So uhh... are you enjoying the movie?"

Five

Panel 1: The Person gets up from the bed, throwing the blanket off. The egg remains on top of the dresser.

Narration: "I give up."

Panel 2: The Person is brushing their teeth in the mirror in front of the sink. The egg is on the other side of the sink.

Panel 3: The Person is in the shower. The egg remains on the top of the sink.

Panel 4: The Person has changed and is applying deodorant. The egg is on top of the dresser.

Panel 5: The Person is crouched in front of the fridge, reaching for a container. The Egg is next to The Person.

Six

Panel 1: Close up on The Person's hands reaching for a container containing a rotisserie chicken.

Panel 2: The rotisserie chicken is in the microwave. Above is an icon of The Person with a sweat drop showing embarrassment.

Inner dialogue: "Yes, this is an entire rotisserie chicken for breakfast. Don't judge."

Panel 3: The Person is sitting at a table with a chicken drumstick held to their watering mouth. The egg is next to them on the table.

Panel 4: The egg is cracking. The Person is glaring at the egg, a frown on their face. The drumstick is still held.

Panel 5: The egg has hatched and a baby dragon is extending its open mouth towards the drumstick still being held. The Person is still glaring.

Dialogue: “Oh okay fatass.”

Seven

Panel 1: Close up on the baby dragon’s face, smiling with its mouth open.

Panel 2: Close up on the baby dragon’s eyes.

Panel 3: Close up on the dragon’s eyes (duplicate of **Page 2, Panel 2**).
