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Panel 1: The comic starts with the visuals of an open field. Panel 5: Close-up of the hero's face, which is full of despair and dread. The reality of his father's death is setting in.

1. Villain's Inner Thoughts: Oh well.

Panel 6: Close-up of villain's face, the Villain is smirking, feeling empowered, no sympathy to be found in his eyes.

1. Villain's Inner Thoughts: I can live with that.

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Panel 7: Close-up on the main character's mouth. He screams in pain and sorrow, but most of all hate.

1. Hero: "I'LL KILL YOUUUUUUUU!"

Panel 8: Close-up of the main character's eyes, rage fills them, over-taking all other emotions as he looks up at his father's murderer.

1. Hero: "HOW DARE YOUUUUUUUU!"

Panel 9: Full view of the main character kneeling in the dirt. Wings shredded and exposed, an ugly view, as he buries his face into his hands and yells out words of hate to the villain. His own sanity was leaving him.

1. Hero: "HOW DARE YOU KILL A WARRIOR LIKE MY FATHER!"

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Panel 10: Close-up of the villain's face, twisted in joy as he spills poisonous truths into the hero's ears.

1. Villain: "That man wasn't worthy of being called a **father**."

Panel 11: Flashback to 18 years ago. A burning village is shown, human-like figures burning a town down are depicted, a child's body lying lifeless, and a trail of blood flows from it. The tall human figures hold torches, the same ones used to burn the village down.

Panel 12: A close-up of Hero's father's face is shown, eyes cold, no mercy to be found.

Hero's Father: "Clean up these rats, kill all the women and children! We can't let any of them live."

Panel 13: A 6-year-old villain hiding behind bushes all alone as he watches the atrocities that are being done to his village, tears streaming down his face, while his eyes are empty, no emotions to be found. (End of flashback)

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Panel 14: Fast forward to the present. The villain shoots a cruel smile at the hero as he speaks his truth about the hero's father. The villain is filled with absolute amusement at the heroes' disbelief at the truth.

1. Villain: "Your father was a disgusting government dog; he was no warrior."

Panel 15: The side profile of the hero is shown as he yells in rage at the villain, not believing for a second that what the villain is saying could be the truth.

1. Hero: "LIARRRRRRRRRRRR!"

Panel 16: The hero's eyes are shown blinded by rage as he yells at the top of his lungs a death threat to the villain for killing his beloved father.

1. Hero: "I'LL KILL YOUUUUUUU!"

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Panel 17: Front profile of the main character's face, looking up at the villain, screaming in rage, eyes full of hate, hair flowing in the wind, tears running down his face.

1. Hero: "I'LL BE THE LAST THING YOU SEE!"

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Panel 18: There is a close-up of the villain's eyes as he chuckles in response to the hero. Emotionless amusement filled his stunning eyes.

1. Villain: "Hah!"

Panel 19: The villain burns the body of the hero's father to ash. There is a close-up view of the villain in the sky, holding the hero's father by the neck, burning his body.

Panel 20: Hero watches as his father's ashes fall to the ground. There is a close-up of the hero's side profile, eyes filled with grief, ashes from his dead father's body falling from the sky onto his face.

Panel 21: Hero tries to catch his father's ashes. The hero is shown reaching out for ashes that seem to fly right past him.

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Panel 22: The hero's eyes are filled with complete despair. There is a close-up of the hero's eyes, depicting the emptiness the hero is feeling at the loss of his beloved father. He is unable to contain the tears streaming down his face.

Panel 23: The hero holds his father's ashes in his hands. There is a close-up of the hero's hands, his father's ashes slipping right through them.

1. Villain Inner Thoughts: I am...

Panel 24: Hero falls to his knees and screams. The panel depicts the hero at his absolute lowest, groveling in the grass and mud, screaming in terror at the truth that faces him. His wings ripped to shreds, pain both physical and emotional ripping through him as he bows his head down into the dirt, crying for his dead father.
